Independent Auditor's Review Report on the Quarterly Unaudited Standalone Financial Results of the Company Pursuant to the Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended

To
The Board of Directors
Twenty Five South Realty Limited,
Mumbai

1. We have reviewed the accompanying statement of Standalone Unaudited Financial Results of **Twenty Five South Realty Limited** ('the Company') for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 ('the Statement'), being submitted by the Company pursuant to the requirement of Regulation 52 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('the Regulations').
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's management and has been approved by the Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" ('Ind AS 34'), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 and other recognised accounting principles generally accepted in India. Our responsibility is to issue a report on the Statement based on our review.
3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagement's (SRE) 2410 "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity" issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India (ICAI). This standard requires that we plan and perform the review to obtain moderate assurance as to whether the Statement is free of material misstatement. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.
4. Basis for qualified opinion:
 - i. As stated in Note No. 6 to the accompanying standalone financial results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, regarding the non-recognition of interest income amounting to ₹ 25.73 lacs on certain intercorporate deposits. Consequent to the above, finance income for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 has been understated by ₹ 25.73 lacs leading to a corresponding understatement in the reported profit for the quarter ended June 30, 2026.
 - ii. As stated in Note No. 7 to the accompanying standalone financial results of the Company for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, regarding the non-recognition of premium on redemption amounting to ₹ 8,536.72 lacs on certain NCD's, as the management is currently in discussions with the subscriber for re-negotiation of the debenture terms. Consequent to the above, finance expense for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 has been understated by ₹ 8,536.72 lacs leading to a corresponding



understatement of inventories / overstatement of reported profit for the quarter ended June 30, 2026.

5. Based on our review conducted as above, except for the effects of the matter described in paragraph 4 above, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standards ('Ind AS') specified under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, read with relevant rules issued thereunder and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of the Listing Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
6. Emphasis of Matter:
We draw attention to:
- Note No. 8 of the standalone financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, regarding the comparative financial information for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 includes the figures for corresponding quarter ended June 30, 2025, which are based on the unaudited financial results for the period ended June 30, 2025.
 - Note No. 5 of the standalone financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, regarding recognition of expense for ongoing projects which is based upon estimated costs, as per the judgment of the management and have been relied upon by us, these being technical matters.
 - Note No. 9 of the standalone financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026, regarding the provision for gratuity and leave encashment being recognized based on the actuarial valuation report of the previous year, instead of an actuarial valuation carried out as at the current reporting date.

Our report is not qualified in respect of the above matter.

The limited review of the results for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 was carried out by the Statutory Auditors of the Company M/s. A R C K & Co., Chartered Accountants.
2. The above financial results are in accordance with the Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) as prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 3 of the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Rules, 2015 and the Companies (Indian Accounting Standards) Amendment Rules, 2016. 8. The comparative financial information for the quarter ended June 30, 2026 includes figures for the corresponding quarter ended June 30, 2025, which are based on unaudited standalone financial results for the quarter ended June 30, 2025.
9. During the quarterly period, provision for gratuity and leave encashment being recognized based on the actuarial valuation report of the previous year.
